October Presentation: Anna Katalkina

In October, Anna Katalkina, MAS President, treated us to a demo of oil transfer and shared the process of creating her artwork. To transfer the drawings for her contemporary realistic paintings, Anna prefers oil transfer, the technique used by Dutch Old Masters, that produces archivable results. She starts by creating a drawing, then applies a thin layer of burnt umber to a sheet of tracing paper and smoothes it with a cloth. The goal is to leave a very thin layer of burnt umber, creating an oil transfer paper.

Anna demonstrated not only how to transfer the initial drawing but also how to add outlines of details like patterns to a painting in progress, sharing many tips and tricks that were highly appreciated by MAS members and the general public attending the presentation.









Upcoming November Presentation: Deborah Conn

For our November 17th meeting, we are excited to see Deborah Conn, a Signature member of the Potomac Valley Watercolorists, the Baltimore Watercolor Society, the Virginia Watercolor Society, who has just recently been selected as a Signature member of both the Northwest Watercolor Society and the National Watercolor Society.

Deborah's favorite subjects are people. She works in watercolor, acrylics, collage, and various drawing media. Deborah will demonstrate her technique in creating portraits using a painting surface of crinkled tissue paper.

From Anna Katalkina


Here is the painting, which Anna Katalkina used in her October meeting demo. It is now finished and framed! "Lady and a Black Cat," 8"x10", oil on linen.
